



### Dear Parishioners,

While the Republican National Convention is happening now in Milwaukee, tens of thousands of Catholics are gathered in Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress. When blasphemy and division seek to destroy us as a Country and a Church, the Lord in the Most blesses Sacrament keeps us united. Through love of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, the Holy "Communion" of the Eucharist forms one Church, one "Communion" of believers which keeps the Church united as one family. As Saint Paul says, "Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf (1 Corinthians 10:16-17." One thing we can definitely pray for then is for the success of the Eucharistic congress, that it will continue to help unite our Church and spread devotion to the Most Blessed Sacrament across our Country. Let's also remember that we don't have to drive to Indiana to adore the Lord in the Eucharist, when He is here in our midst, waiting for us to visit Him in the tabernacle or in the monstrance. For those of you who want to make prayer more a part of your life, I invite you to come to Wednesday adoration (we could also use more adorers to fill time slots).

This past Monday I was able to meet with Bishop Lohse to discuss how I have been settling in, as well as the various topics of concern which we desired to speak to each other about, including the issues which a number of you have raised to me upon my arrival. I am pleased to say that from my perspective, the meeting went very well. Bishop Lohse brings to his administration of our diocese a pastoral wisdom for which I am very grateful.

One of a number of things we agreed on, and that he urged me to look into immediately, was the need for a parish council for our two-church community. In the next couple of weeks, I will be speaking to priest friends and mentors as to the best possible way to get this done. Furthermore, as I am aware that we did used to have a parish council for our communities, I would be interested to learn from former members of the old parish council the bylaws and practices of how things used to work in parish council so that we can figure out what will work best for us.

In our gospel this Sunday, Jesus looks with compassion on the people, "for they were like sheep without a Shepherd (Mark 6:34)." Let's take some time this week to pray for our current administrator, Bishop Lohse, that his time among us may be fruitful, and let us also pray for our next bishop, that he will be a shepherd after the heart of Christ who will not abandon the flock, but guide and govern it wisely.
